Challenge in the present petition is to the orders dated 31.01.2024 (Annexure P-7) and dated 15.03.2024 (Annexure P-8), whereby the promotions of the petitioners as Steno-Typists and Clerks, made vide order dated 26.10.2023 had been withdrawn on account of the petitioners having failed to qualify the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC) for the post of Steno-Typists/Clerks as per the instructions issued by the State of Haryana.

Learned State Counsel has placed reliance on the instructions bearing Memo No.03/15/2024-3FS dated 29.10.2024 clarifying the instructions of 11.07.2024, whereby further chances have been granted to the employees to qualify the SETC in the prescribed timescale. In view of the said development, it is submitted that the petitioners shall be eligible to participate in the SETC which would be held in future. Hence, it is submitted that the order of reversion of the petitioners would not be given effect to.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State Counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
