CWP-4754-2021 along with another connected petition (CWP-4114-2021) was withdrawn on 11.09.2023. However, the Division Bench issued the following directions:-

“5. In view of the above, the learned counsels for the petitioners do not press the writ petitions. Consequently, they pray for and, are permitted to withdraw the writ petitions. Ordered accordingly.

6. However, the respondents concerned, are directed to most expeditiously create, carve commercial plots over the sites concerned, and are also directed to, in terms of the eligibility of each of the petitioners make allotments of commercial plots to each of them.”

2. Learned counsel representing the respondents submits that a decision in terms of the aforesaid directions shall be taken within a period of four weeks from today.

3. That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no grievance subsists, at this stage.

4. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application for revival of the instant
