1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 401 Cr.PC impugning the order dated 20.11.2015 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, whereby the respondents have been discharged under Section 245 Cr.P.C.

2. On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:-
