1. Through the instant petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made of issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus, directing the competent authority amongst the respondents, i.e. respondent No.2, to decide the legal notice dated 12.08.2025 (Annexure P-9), wherethrough, the petitioner has sought correction to her father's name in her matriculation certificate issued by the respondents No.2 and 3.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made the representation/legal notice dated 12.08.2025 (Annexure P-9), to respondents No.2 and 3. However, the said legal notice has not been decided, as on date, which propelled her to file the instant writ petition, seeking *mandamus* upon the respondents concerned, to take apt steps.

3. At this stage, this Court deems it fit and appropriate to pass a mandamus upon the respondent No.2, to decide the legal notice dated 12.08.2025 (Annexure P-9), after providing due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
