1. The petitioner alleges willful disobedience of directions issued vide order dated 21.07.2025 in CWP No. 20836 of 2025;

“In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the notice dated 24.05.2025 (Annexure P-15) submitted by the petitioners, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

2. Sh. Sanjeev Kaushik, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and has produced a copy of speaking order dated 22.08.2025 passed in compliance of the aforesaid directions. A copy thereof has also been supplied to learned counsel for petitioner.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not press the instant contempt petition and shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as admissible in law against the said order.

4. That being so, the instant contempt petition is dismissed as not having been pressed.
