1. Prayer in the present Civil Revision Petition, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is for setting aside the impugned order dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-4), passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), SAS Nagar, Mohali, in a Rent Petition No. 119 of 2024, titled *Manbir Kaur Dhaliwal vs. Atul Sharma and others*, whereby the application for setting aside the *ex parte* proceedings dated 03.07.2025 was allowed in favour of the respondent-tenant.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he restricts his prayer only to the extent that the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), SAS Nagar, Mohali, may be directed to dispose of the case expeditiously.
