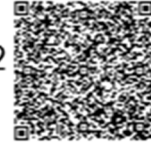

Notice of the application to the non-applicants/respondents.



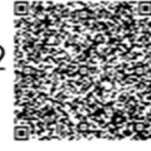
Mr. S.S.Chahal, learned AAG, Punjab and Ms. Manjot Kaur, learned AAG, Punjab accept notice on behalf of the non-applicant/respondent Nos.1 & 3 to 6 and raises no objection to the present application.

In view of the above and for the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Annexures P-21 to P-24 are taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

**MAIN CASE**

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (*for short 'Cr.P.C.'*), *inter alia*, with the following prayers:-

- (i) for transferring the investigation of FIR No.85 dated 02.11.2020, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (*for short 'NDPS Act'*), registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot to Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI);
- (ii) for directing respondent No.7/NHAI for preventing and providing the CCTV Footages from the Toll Plazas (list attached as P-10) from 31.10.2020 to 02.11.2020 of the truck bearing registration No.RJ-13-GB-0775;
- (iii) for constitution of a Special Medical Board, consisting of senior Doctors from PGI, Chandigarh to ascertain the damage/loss of health suffered by the petitioner as his eyesight had been badly affected due to the atrocity caused by the police officials;
- (iv) for staying the presentation of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. during the pendency of present petition.



(2) After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that present petition be disposed off as not pressed “at this stage” and liberty be granted to raise all his plea(s) before learned Special Court in accordance with law.

(3) Disposed off with liberty aforesaid.

(4) It is clarified that above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the allegations in any manner.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
