VIKAS BAHL, J (ORAL)

1. This is a civil original contempt petition filed under Section 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for taking action against the respondents/contemners.
2. Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.3 has submitted that the respondents have already released an amount of Rs.53,39,492/- which as per them is the amount due to the petitioners.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that as per the petitioners, some other amount is also due and has further submitted that in case the present petition is being disposed of, then liberty be granted to the petitioners to institute proceedings in accordance with law for recovery of the balance amount.

4. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has submitted that in case, any such proceedings are instituted, then liberty be granted to the respondents to raise all pleas, as are available to them.

5. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of. Liberty is granted to the petitioners as prayed for. In case any such proceedings are initiated, it would be open for both the parties to raise all pleas in accordance with law.
