1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the respondents not to harass the petitioner and his family, as the petitioner was declared innocent during the enquiry conducted by A.D.G.P, Bathinda.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 07.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) to the ADGP-Punjab, Bathinda Range, Bathinda-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, to look into representation dated 07.04.2025

(Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
