SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 26.05.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-6197-2025.

2. The relevant portion of order dated 26.05.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-6197-2025, is reproduced as under:-

“3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Sitara Singh, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Ajnala, submits that infact the above referred inquiry report dated 25.01.2023 (Annexure P-1) was lacking in material particulars and a fresh inquiry has been initiated, which is being conducted by District Development and Panchayat Officer, Amritsar and that since proceedings already stand pending, the matter



would be concluded within a period of three months from today.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this writ petition, at this stage.”

5. In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
