1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents No.1 to 3, to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners, who apprehend threat to their life at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 12, who are stated to be family members of petitioner No.1 and not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioners and further to consider the representation dated 03.10.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are in live-in-relationship and are being threatened with dire consequences by the private respondents. Resultantly, a representation dated 03.10.2025 (Annexure P-3) was also made to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Kaithal for protection of their lives and



liberty but in vain. Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Kaithal to look into their representation and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of Official respondents.

5. In view of above, petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Kaithal to provide necessary protection to the petitioners after considering threat perceptions to their life and liberty and to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.

6. Pending misc. application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
