MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner has rushed to this Court merely after expiry of one month which is the stipulated time for complying with the orders of this Court.

The order of this Court was served upon the respondents by the petitioner on 22.08.2013 and that would imply that period of one month would expire on 22.09.2013. Merely a week thereafter, the petitioner has rushed to this Court without even serving a notice of demand for compliance of orders of this Court.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition.

The petition is, therefore, permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to serve a notice upon the respondents in the first instance and in case the respondents fail to comply with the orders of this Court within a reasonable time, the petitioner is at liberty to approach this Court once again.
