SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India *inter-alia* for staying execution proceeding bearing CHCH02-001242-2022 EXE/211/2022 titled as “*Vinod Kumar and others Versus Harinder Kaur and others*”, which is pending before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh and for staying warrant of possession dated 17.01.2025, Annexure P-4.
2. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the impugned order, possession of the property has been taken over by the respondents. He submits that in so far as the instant revision petition is concerned, the same has become infructuous. He, however, submits that judgment and decree dated 18.12.2024 is subject matter of challenge in an appeal, which is pending before the learned Additional District Judge, Chandigarh and the proceedings have been deferred for 04.02.2025. He submits that the first appellate court be directed to decide the appeal in a time bound manner.
3. Request of the counsel has been considered.
4. As the appeal filed by the petitioner is pending, the appellate court shall make an endeavour and decide the appeal as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six months from the receipt of the record from the Trial Court.
5. Revision petition is disposed off.
6. Pending application is also disposed off.
