Learned counsel for the respondent relies upon an office communication dated 23.04.2025 to submit that a sum of Rs.13,00,000/- has been sanctioned in favour of the petitioner as expenditure towards liver transplant and the same has been released.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule discharged.

However, in case, any claim of the petitioner still survives including that of interest etc., he would be at liberty to raise his claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent, the officer concerned would be liable to pay cost(s) of Rs.50,000/- to the petitioner from his/her own pocket.
