Prayer in this petition is for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful disobedience of the order dated 05.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP-29402-2024 titled as “Ankit vs. Canara Bank and another” whereby the petition was disposed of with direction to the respondents to pass a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of four months.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that order dated 05.11.2024 directing the respondents to pass a speaking order in respect of ex-gratia appointment of the petitioner, has not been complied with till date.



Learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the said assertion of the petitioner is incorrect, as an order dated 07.3.2025 has been passed in the matter, whereby the case of the petitioner has been rejected. It is submitted that the said order was also duly communicated to the petitioner by way of speed post, and Tracking Report shows that the said order was delivered to the petitioner on 12.3.2025. A copy of the said order dated 07.3.2025 and Tracking Report are handed over in Court and are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to dispute the abovesaid facts.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.
