Learned counsel for respondents No. 3 and 4 informs that in pursuance to the recommendation letter dated 15.01.2025; the name of the petitioner is being recommended for the post of Lower Division Clerk, even he has been granted provisional appointment and the entire process regarding the regular appointment shall be concluded within a period of 15 days from today and he shall be made to join.
