1. The present Contempt Petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for taking an appropriate action against the respondents for not complying with the interim order dated 27.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-2011-2025, titled as 'Bijender Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others', filed by the petitioners herein.

2. Pursuant to the notice of motion order dated 24.04.2025, passed by this Court, the respondents have furnished 02 separate compliance reports in the Registry dated (i) 20.06.2025 by way of affidavit of Sh. Saurabh Ahlawat (respondent No. 5 herein), Executive Engineer, Public Health Division No. 1, Yamuna Nagar qua petitioner No. 1-Bijender Kumar; and (ii) dated 23.06.2025 by way of affidavit of Sh. Dinesh Gaba (respondent No. 6 herein), Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division No. 2, Yamuna Nagar qua petitioners No. 2 and 3, namely, Mahavir Singh and Narinder Kumar. Learned counsel for



the State has also handed over the third compliance report dated 01.07.2025, by way of affidavit of Sh. Surya Kant (respondent No. 7 herein), Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division No. 2, Bhiwani. All the aforesaid 03 compliance reports are taken on record. Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that the interim order dated 27.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) stands duly complied with and nothing survives in the present petition.

3. Copies thereof, have also been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners who after going through the same submits that in view of the above, no cause survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed of.

4. In view of the above, the present petition stands **disposed of**.

5. Rule stands discharged.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
