Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 08.4.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-10266-2025 titled as "Renu vs. State of Haryana and others" vide which the petition was disposed of with the following observations :-

“xxx xxx xxx

4. *Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending representation, dated 13.09.2023, will be decided by the second respondent/Director General, Higher Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.*

5. *In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof....”*



In pursuance of order dated 22.8.2025 passed by this Court, learned State counsel has already filed the Compliance Report dated 10.09.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri S. Narayanan, IFS, Director General Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula in the Registry, which is annexed with the file. The said Compliance Report alongwith annexed Annexure R-1 is ordered to be taken on record. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State also submits that necessary compliance has been made while passing a Speaking Order dated 25.8.2025 (Annexure R-1); thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

There is no representation on behalf of petitioner.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the respondent that the order dated 08.4.2025 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with and a Speaking Order dated 25.8.2025 (Annexure R-1) has been passed by respondent-authority, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid Speaking Order as per law, if so advised.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
