The petitioner alleges willful disobedience of the order 26.11.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-31807-2024, titled as *Roshan Light and Sound Service v. Election Commission of India and others*.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel has furnished a communication dated 04.06.2025, stated to have been issued to Sh. Parvesh Chug, Advocate, accompanied by a copy of order dated 27.02.2025 which is stated to have been passed in compliance with the directions issued vide order dated 26.11.2024 (Annexure P-1).

3. Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that, although the opportunity of hearing as directed was not granted, the petitioner shall avail all such remedies as are admissible to him to impugn the said order. He submits that under the circumstances, he does not press the present petition.
