HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondents, while relying upon an order dated 14.05.2025, submits that the services of petitioner have been regularized w.e.f. 24.05.2011 on the post of Pump Operator and further, on instructions from Sh. Charandeep Singh, Executive Engineer, Deptt. of Water Supply and Sanitation, Division No. 3, Amritsar, assures that in terms of the order passed by the Writ Court, necessary arrears thereof with effect from 38 months prior to the date of filing of writ petition, shall be released in favour of the petitioner within four weeks from today.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed off** accordingly.

[3] It is made clear that in case the needful is not done as per undertaking, salary of respondent No. 2, upto the extent of one-third, shall remain attached till the compliance is made.
