1. Learned counsel for the appellant, after some arguments, prays to allow him to move appropriate application for recalling of the earlier order of withdrawal passed in previous writ petition.
2. Learned counsel submits that similar writ petitions are already pending before the Single Judge with regard to the same issue which he has raised. However, erroneously, he filed second writ petition making the same prayers which has been dismissed by the learned Single Judge imposing costs.
3. Learned counsel submits that the appellant/petitioner has already deposited the costs. However, he prays that the observations made by the learned Single Judge in his order dated 15.07.2024 may not come in his way for seeking recall of the earlier order dated 07.02.2024.

4. We have considered the submissions and perused the various orders and the writ petition filed by the petitioner earlier as well as the writ petition pending before the Single Judge. Considering that the issue is still alive before the learned Single Judge, which was raised by the petitioner but the writ petition was withdrawn on erroneous legal advice, we allow the appellant to move appropriate application before the learned Single Judge accordingly.
5. It is made clear that the observations made in impugned judgment dated 15.07.2024 would not come in his way.
6. In view of the aforesaid observations, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
7. All pending applications also stand disposed of accordingly.
