ANOOP CHITKARA, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for cancellation of bail under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C granted to respondent No.2 by this Court vide order dated 21.08.2023 passed in CRM-M-2410-2023 titled as 'Beant Kaur Vs. State of Punjab.
2. Counsel for the petitioner seeks cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 on the ground that she resiled from the settlement based on which she was granted bail.
3. Counsel for respondent No.2 submits that she has no means to honour the settlement and in compliance to the order dated 15.05.2025, counsel for respondent No.2 has voluntarily handed over her original affidavit mentioning her assets, one copy to the petitioner and one copy to the State. There is no need for this Court to keep any copy because declaration of assets will not have bearing on the outcome. Counsel for respondent No.2 submits that affidavit has been voluntarily filed and she will not claim such declaration as any incrimination or violation of their rights under Articles 20/21 of the Constitution of India, Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam, 2023 or any other law in force.
4. Since, the respondent provided detail of her assets; as such, complainant is at liberty to take legal remedies in accordance with law for recovery of his amount, if any. This Court is not inclined to cancel the bail on the ground raised by petitioner.
4. There is no allegation of accused interfering in investigation or repeating the offence. Further, The reason not to cancel the bail further supported by the conduct of the accused in voluntarily declaring her assets. As such, no ground is made out to cancel the bail.
5. Given above, present petition is dismissed. All the pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
