1. This petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, alleging wilful disobedience of order dated 29.04.2025 passed by this Court in CRWP-4264-2025, titled as *XXXX XXXX vs. State of Punjab and others*.

2. Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent, on an advance copy of petition having been served upon her. She states that in deference to the order dated 29.04.2025, despite several opportunities having been granted to the petitioner, she has not come forward. Nonetheless, upon consideration of the complaint filed by the petitioner, FIR No.28 dated 28.06.2025, has since been registered under Sections 376, 384 IPC, at Police Station Women Cell, SAS Nagar.

3. In view of the aforesaid, substantial compliance of order dated 29.04.2025 has been made and hence, no further orders are called for in the present matter.
