Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that order dated 22.05.2024 passed in CWP-11729-2024 has been complied with, as such, he does not press the present petition.

However, with regard to claim of the petitioner towards delayed disbursement of interest, he would be at liberty to raise his claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from the release of payments, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent, the officer concerned would be liable to pay cost(s) of Rs.50,000/- to the petitioner from his/her own pocket.
