1. The appellants/defendants have filed the present appeal against the concurrent findings of the learned Courts below whereby the suit filed by the respondents/plaintiff-Tirlok Chand for declaration with consequential relief of permanent and mandatory injunction had been decreed.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the appellants submits that the question of law involved in the present appeal as to whether jurisdiction of the Civil Court is barred in view of Section 145 of the Electricity Act, 2003, has since been decided by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in **RSA-4181-2016**, titled as '**Mahesh Kumar vs. Sub Divisional Officer and Another**' vide judgment dated 14.05.2025.



3. In view of the above, the present second appeal is **allowed**, and the suit filed by the respondents-plaintiff stands dismissed on the ground of jurisdiction. However, the respondents-plaintiff are at liberty to take recourse to the appropriate remedy as available, in accordance with law.

4. It is made clear that any evidence recorded/observations made in the impugned judgments and decrees would not operate as *res judicata* in any subsequent proceedings initiated by the respondents-plaintiff.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
