1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS) seeking quashing of FIR No.0041 dated 09.03.2024 registered under Sections 420, 498-A, 406 and 34 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station City South, Moga (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising thereof.

2. Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the matter has been settled between the parties before the Mediation & Conciliation Center of this Court vide settlement/agreement dated 07.07.2025. Today during the course of hearing a demand draft of

Rs.8,50,000/- the due balance amount of the settlement has been handed over to the learned counsel for the respondents No.2 and 3 for onward transmission to respondent No.3 for encashment.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the said settlement.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that, if any, such petition is filed by the petitioners, the respondents No.2 and 3 shall make a statement before the trial Court for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the said settlement.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
