The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail in case FIR No.23, dated 27.01.2025, registered under Sections 190,191(2),191(3),115(2), 333, 351(2),61(2),117 of B.N.S (old Sections 149,147,148,323,452,506,308,325 and 120-B of IPC) at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation may not be required.

4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
