RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 14.12.2023 passed by this court in CWP-15404-2019.

2. In compliance of order dated 14.12.2023, the counsel for respondents has placed on record the status report by way of affidavit, along with supporting documents, which is taken on record. The Registry is directed to scan the same and make it part of the soft copy of the case.

3. The counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by passing order dated 02.07.2024, whereby the service of the petitioner has



been counted as qualifying service towards pensionary benefits. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
