HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the present revision petition has been made for quashing/setting aside the order dated 12.12.2022 passed by the Additional District Judge Sangrur, whereby second objection petition filed at the instance of respondent-State have been ordered to be considered.

2. The main contention of the petitioner-landowners is that the first objection petition filed at the instance of respondent-State was dismissed by the Executing Court vide order dated 20.12.2017, by passing a detailed and comprehensive order but now by way of filing second objection petition, the respondents are trying to re-open the said order which was never assailed by way of any revision petition and thus, attained finality.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that through the second objection petition, the respondents were only pointing out the discrepancy made by the Executing Court while passing the order dated 20.12.2017, besides it, the revision petition was premature as the objection petition was yet to be decided on merits.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties at length and gone through the paper-book.
5. A perusal of the record shows that upon the second objection petition filed on behalf of the respondents, merely case has been adjourned for 21.02.2023 for consideration upon the objections and the same are yet to be dealt with on merits, the petitioners shall have their right to oppose these objections and their only grouse at this stage appears to be the delay being caused in the execution proceedings on account of filing second objection petition at the instance of respondents.
6. In view of the discussions made hereinabove, the Executing Court is requested to dispose of the second objections either on the date fixed i.e. 03.05.2025 or within 02 weeks thereafter.
7. Disposed of in the above terms.
8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
