By way of filing the present second appeal, the plaintiff-appellant has laid challenge to the concurrent judgments of both the Courts below as, they failed to give a finding with regard to the plea of the appellant of the order of transfer having been passed in derogation of Rule 2(h)(b) read with Rule 6 and Serial No. 31 of Appendix 'C' of Haryana Municipal Corporation Employees (Recruitment and Conditions) Service Rules, 1998, as per which the Appointing Authority of the appellant on the post of Inspector was a Commissioner whereas the impugned order had been passed by the Joint Commissioner.

At the very outset, learned Senior Counsel for the respondents submits that the present second appeal has been rendered infructuous as, the present second appeal has been filed against the order of transfer whereby the appellant had been transferred from one branch to another. It is submitted that the appellant already stands retired on 30.11.2017. Learned Senior Counsel has handed over in Court a copy of



office order No. MCF/S-1/2017/2717 dated 17.11.2017, which is taken on record. It is accordingly, submitted that nothing survives in the instant second appeal and the same be disposed of, accordingly.

Perusal of the order-sheets reveals that on the last date of hearing i.e. 06.02.2019, the appellant had gone un-represented. Even today also, there is no representation on behalf of the appellant.

In view of the above, the present second appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, with liberty to the appellant to revive the same by way of filing an appropriate application, in case, anything survives within a period of 03 months from today.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
