1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of the order dated 06.02.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti, in case FIR No.342, dated 15.12.2014 registered under Sections 3(i) and 3(x) of Scheduled Casts and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act), 1989 and Section 376-D IPC at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

2. On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:-

In terms of order dated 01.05.2017, learned State counsel had apprised that all the three petitioners have been declared proclaimed offender on 06.02.2017.

The reply by way of affidavit of Devinder Singh Sandhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran on behalf of the respondent-State is already on record.

Learned State counsel submits that subsequently, Bikramjit Singh- petitioner No.1 and Prabhdyal @ Babbi-

petitioner No.2 have been arrested and were released on bail. However, petitioner No.3-Pala Singh @ Amritpal Singh has since died.

Adjourned to 18.01.2023.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since petitioners No.1 & 2 were arrested and were released on bail and are now facing trial and petitioner No.3 has since died, therefore, the instant petition has become infructuous.
