1. This appeal arises out of an order dated 09.09.2023, passed by the Additional District Judge, Chandigarh under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The commercial Court has rejected the delay condonation application and consequently the objection made under Section 34 of the Act, 1996.

2. The commercial Court has observed that there exists no provision whereunder the prescribed period of limitation for filing of objection could be extended. Reliance is placed upon the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Union of India Vs. M/s Popular Construction Co. 2001(8) SCC 470**.

3. It is well settled that the Act of 1996 is a self contained Code and the limitation prescribed for filing of objection cannot be extended under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963.

4. In that view of the matter, the appeal is dismissed.
