1. Petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 03.12.2024, Annexure P-6, passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Fazilka.
2. Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of order dated 08.01.2025 passed by the Executing Court to submit that the judgment debtor has handed over a demand draft of Rs.23,85,635/- to the decree holder, who has withdrawn the execution petition as being fully satisfied. He submits that as the instant revision petition arises out of an interim order passed by the Executing Court, which has been withdrawn, petition has become infructuous.
