**Sumeet Goel (Oral):**

1. The substantive prayer made in the present petition reads thus:

*“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and the action against private respondent No.4 to 6 may kindly be initiated on disturbing the law and order in the village by trying to raise Gurudwara in the Panchayat Land without any title authority and further creating terror amongst the villagers, in the interest of justice.”*

2. Pursuant to the State having been called upon, status report by way of affidavit of Shri Deepak Hilori, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot has been filed, relevant thereof reads thus:

*“2. That in due compliance of order dated 13.11.2019 passed by this Hon'ble High Court, the report has been obtained from the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rural, Pathankot. As per the report, the petitioner had filed a representation dated 21.05.2019 i.e. Annexure P-3 before SHO Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh regarding illegal possession of Panchayat land by private respondents. During the inquiry, the matter was found to be of civil nature. However, preventive action under section 107/150 Cr.P.C was initiated against the private respondents and other persons vide DDR No. 37 dated 29.05.2019 Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh. Kalandra under section 107/150 Cr.P.C. has also been presented in the Court of Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Pathankot. Next date of hearing in the said Court is 13.02.2020.*

3. *That the petitioner had filed a representation dated 03.06.2019 (Annexure P-4) before the office of the then SSP/Pathankot regarding creating terror by the some resident of Village alongwith un-identified person with their weapons roaming openly in the streets of Gram Panchayat Kohlian and Gram Panchayat Charak and same was marked to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rural, Pathankot for inquiry. The Inquiry Officer submitted his report on 06.06.2019 that the preventive action has already been initiated against the private respondents and other persons vide DDR No. 37 dated 29.05.2019 Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh. The Kalendra under section 145 Cr.P.C was prepared by SHO Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh vide DDR No. 30 dated 04.06.2019 and presented in the court of Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Pathankot. The next date of hearing in the said Court is 07.02.2020. During the inquiry, the allegations leveled the petitioner against the police officials were found to be false. However, the Inquiry Officer suggest to the both parties to their remedy in Civil Court”*

3. In view of the above, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the petition in hand, at this stage, with liberty to file afresh, in case cause of action so ensues.

4. Ordered accordingly.
