Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of direction to the respondents to take necessary action for further investigation in FIR No.87 dated 14.02.2021, under Section 380 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kundli, District Sonipat.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Vipin Kumar Ahlawat, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Rai District, Sonipat was filed on behalf of respondent-State, wherein it has been alleged that on 16.09.2021 an untraced report was prepared, however, on 19.07.2022 investigation was entrusted to ASI Rakesh and when no breakthrough could be achieved, on 12.03.2023, the matter was again investigated by HC Sudhir and ultimately on 05.08.2024 untraced report was prepared and the same was presented before learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonipat in case State Vs. Unknown, Untr-2116-2024, which was accepted by the Court concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has conceded that order dated 05.08.2024 vide which the untraced report was accepted by the Court concerned, has not been challenged by the petitioner.

Thus, when the efficacious alternative remedy available to the petitioner has not been exhausted, the present petition is not maintainable and is accordingly disposed of.
