Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondents for not complying the order dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by a Predecessor Bench of this Court in CR-1361-2021 titled as “Jasvir Singh vs. Sidhu Agri & Commercial Properties Ltd. and others”, vide which the petition was disposed of and it was ordered that “....*the ad-interim injunction dated 28.4.2021, passed by the trial Court, shall continue till the application for interim injunction is finally decided by the trial Court.*”



Pursuant to notice of motion issued vide order dated 12.3.2024, reply dated 22.7.2024 by way of affidavit of Shri Vikramjeet Singh Panthe, PCS, then Sub Division Magistrate, Balachaur, now Sub Division Magistrate, Banga, District SBS Nagar on behalf of respondent No.1 has already been filed in the Registry, which is annexed on the file. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to grant any relief, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present contempt petition.

Permitted to do so.
