SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 01.04.2025 passed in CRWP-3182-2025.
2. The relevant portion of order dated 01.04.2025, is reproduced as under:-

“Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the representation dated 27.2.2025 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. The order so passed in the said representation shall be communicated to the petitioner within a period of one week thereafter.”



3. Learned State counsel contends that in compliance of order dated 01.04.2025, compliance affidavit of Mr. Swapan Sharma, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, dated 06.08.2025 has been filed along with speaking order dated 27.07.2025, which is attached as Annexure R-1/T.

4. Para 4 of the affidavit dated 06.08.2025, is reproduced as under:-

“4. That in compliance to the above noted order of this Hon'ble Court dated 01.04.2025 (Annexure P- 1), inquiry on the above noted representation of the petitioner dated 27.02.2025 was got conducted through the SHO- P.S.Delhon, Ludhiana. Infact the said Representation was moved by the petitioner and others for protection of life and liberty from their opponents. petitioner Thus in order to join the sent in the inquiry, the said SHO Notices to the Whatsapp ID (Mobile Phone) of the petitioner on 10.04.2025, 12.04.2025 and 20.04.2025 and repeated phone calls were also made to the petitioner to join the inquiry but the petitioner did inquiry. Therefore the join not the said representation of the petitioner dated 27.02.20 was consigned to the office record.

However, thereafter the present petitioner move another representation bearing PGD No.568324 system Id No.569378 dated 08.04.2025 with the answering deponent. Inquiry on the said representation was also entrusted to the SHO- P.S.Dehton, Ludhiana and as the petitioner was apprehending danger from his opponents, therefore peace keeping proceedings u/s 126, 169, 170 of BNSS were launched against the opponents of the petitioner namely Dhanwant Singh, Gurpreet Singh and Sukhwinder Singh vide DDR No.12 dated 12.05.2025.



The above noted Inquiry of the SHO was further examined and verified by the ACP-South, thereafter by the ADCP-II and finally the same was approved as well by the answering deponent by passing a Speaking order dated 27.07.2025. Copy of the said speaking order is attached as Annexure R-1/T.”

5. A perusal of above shows that order dated 01.04.2025 passed in CRWP-3182-2025, has been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. In view of the above, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
7. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
