1. Instant petition has been filed assailing order dated 22.05.2025, Annexure P-11, passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sangrur, whereby an application filed by the petitioners/defendants for rejection of the application under Order 33 Rule 1 CPC has been dismissed.

2. At the outset, Mr. Salar, could not dispute that pursuant to an additional opportunity granted to the plaintiff, he has deposited the requisite court fee before the trial court on 28.05.2025. The sole grievance raised by Mr. Salar is that the Court has shown indulgence and given repeated opportunities to the plaintiff to deposit the court fee despite the fact that the court had come to a conclusion that plaintiff was not a pauper and owned agricultural land.

3. Be that as it may, as the requisite court fee has been deposited for which an opportunity was given by the trial Court, this Court does not intend to interfere with the impugned order.

4. Revision petition is dismissed.
