Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant-petitioner submits that the aforesaid LPA No.1865 of 2015 stands decided vide order dated 05.03.2025 passed by the Division Bench and since the case of the petitioner is fully covered by the same, therefore, the present application be allowed. The main writ petition be taken on Board today itself for final hearing and may be disposed of accordingly.

Main case

The instant writ petition had been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to grant 2nd and 3rd ACP Grade to the petitioner since 2006 and re-fix the pay and pension as per the rules and release all the consequential benefits.

2 Counsel for the petitioner contends that similar controversy was pending before the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in a batch of LPAs including **LPA No.1865 of 2015 titled as 'State of Haryana and others Vs. Parmanand and others'** being the lead case. The said Letters Patent Appeals preferred by the State of Haryana, have been dismissed vide judgment dated 05.03.2025.
