[2] Learned counsel for the respondents, while relying upon an order dated 21.03.2025 & 18.03.2025 (Annexures R-1 & R-2 respectively), submits that the petitioners have been given retrospective appointment w.e.f. 22.09.2020 & 28.09.2020, i.e. the date when their juniors were granted appointment.

[3] In view of the above, no cause survives in the present petition, the same is **disposed off** accordingly.

[5] However, in case, any claim of the petitioners still survives, they would be at liberty to raise their claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioners within a period of two weeks thereafter.
