1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to address her legal notice/representation dated 23.07.2024 (Annexure P-9).
2. The petitioner claims that she joined Punjab Police as Steno Typist on 20.01.1989. She was promoted to the rank of Senior Assistant on 19.09.2006 and transferred from Intelligence Wing to Litigation Wing. The respondent in 2022 has granted ACP to similarly situated employees. She has served legal notice dated 23.07.2024 (Annexure P-9) upon the respondent seeking ACP but to no avail.
3. Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondent-State, assures the Court that competent authority would address petitioner's legal notice within three months from today.
