1. The present petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to investigate and decide the complaint/representation dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) in a free, fair, and impartial manner by a high rank officer within a time-bound period and thereafter to take appropriate action against private respondents No.3 to 5 for demanding dowry and torturing the petitioner

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a complaint was given to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, but no further action has been taken in this regard.

3. At this stage, Mr. P.S. Bhandari, AAG, Punjab, stated that he has received an advance copy of the petition and has specific instructions to state that the complaint which was given by the petitioner to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, was thoroughly processed and has been consigned to the record room, as nothing was found in the complaint



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition in order to enable the petitioner to invoke the alternate remedy available to her in accordance with law, including filing of a criminal complaint before the concerned Court \.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
