SUBHAS MEHLA, J (Oral):

1. Petitioner has filed petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 (erstwhile Section 482 Cr.P.C.) for quashing of FIR No.180, dated 18.06.2024, under Sections 323 and 506 of IPC and Section 325 of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Rohtak Sadar, District Rohtak (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising thereto on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to trial Court to make endeavour for the disposal of his application which the parties want to move for permission to compound the offences.

3. Heard.

4. Petition is disposed of with a direction to learned trial Court to decide the application if any moved by parties for compounding of offence in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably within a period of two weeks.
