The petitioner had filed CWP No.12797 of 2017 seeking directions to the respondent/MC, Jalalabad to decide his Legal Notice dated 27.04.2017 (**Annexure P-2**) in a time bound manner. The said petition was disposed of, vide order dated 01.06.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) with directions to the respondent to consider the aforesaid Legal Notice and decide the same within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of that order. It was also ordered that if there is no legal impediment in releasing the remaining retiral benefits of the petitioner, the same shall be released to him forthwith along with interest as per government instructions. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions have already been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned opposite Counsel.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
