The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.140 dated 05.10.2024 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC and Section 82 of Registration Act, at Police Station Haibowal, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
