1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for quashing the order dated 19.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Patiala in case arising out of FIR No.24 dated 10.12.2024 registered under Sections 379B, 506 and 34 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Samana, District Patiala, whereby his bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited to the State due to his non-appearance as well as order dated 25.04.2025 whereby fresh warrant of arrest have been issued against the petitioner.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner could not appear on 19.03.2024 as he was suffering from viral fever and due to communication gap between him and his counsel. He is ready to join the proceedings before the trial Court and to abide by the terms and conditions to be imposed upon him. Therefore, prayer has been made for allowing the present petition.

Though, no illegality seems to have been committed by learned trial Court while passing the impugned order, however, in view of the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage to grant the petitioner one opportunity to surrender before the trial Court and further keeping in view the fact that the absence of the petitioner does not attract the consequences of detaining him into custody as he is willing to join the trial and the ultimate aim is to ensure timely disposal of the cases before the learned trial Court, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court on 22.05.2025 and it is further ordered that on his surrender and on moving appropriate application, the learned trial Court shall admit him to bail subject to deposit of costs of ₹5,000/- with DLSA, Patiala and further subject to his furnishing personal as well as surety bonds to its satisfaction. However, this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed if the petitioner does not abide by this order.

Petition stands disposed of.
