The petitioners have approached this Court seeking directions to the respondents to grant the benefits of their past services, rendered with the respondents and pay of the petitioners be fixed accordingly and a further direction be issued to grant the benefits to the petitioners under the letter/order dated 07.03.2018 on parity with similar situated persons.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this juncture, the petitioners would be satisfied in case respondent No.3-the Civil Surgeon, Rewari, District Rewari is directed to decide the representation dated 20.03.2025 (Annexure P-9) and the grievance espoused by the petitioners therein by passing a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.
