The petitioner is the ex-wife of the respondent-husband. In the decree for mutual divorce, one of the terms was that the custody of the minor girl child would remain with the wife.

The present contempt petition has been filed as the respondent/ex-husband has filed a suit for custody of the minor girl in violation of the settled terms and conditions.

In compliance of the directions, the parties were present on the previous date of hearing and after interaction, an amicable settlement was arrived at.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent states that the respondent has since withdrawn his suit for custody and hence the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

In view of the stand of the respondent, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that nothing survives in the present contempt petition.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, the present contempt petition is dismissed as infructuous.

The respondent shall be bound by his statement, made through his Counsel.
