1. This petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 07.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP-21460-2022.
2. Mr. Suneel Ranga, DAG, Haryana, present in Court on an advance copy of petition having been served on him, puts in appearance on behalf of the respondents. It is brought to the attention of the Court that in deference to the order dated 07.08.2024, election schedule was notified on 04.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) and as per the said schedule, elections have taken place on 09.07.2025 and the result thereof, also stands declared. It is further submitted that though the petition is dated 06.07.2025 but the same was instituted only on 10.07.2025, i.e. after the declaration of the election result. Moreover, the advance copy of the instant petition has been emailed



to the office of the learned Advocate General, Haryana, on 10.07.2025 at 10:53 AM.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that vide order dated 07.08.2024, the District Registrar, Firms and Societies, Hisar, was directed to hold the elections to the governing body of the Haryana Basketball Association in a time bound manner, preferably within a period of six months, subject to any dispute that may be raised with respect to the membership of the Association. It is further submitted that the said order also noticed that some dispute was pending by way of Appeal No.1380 of 2023, which had already been heard by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana and the order was awaited. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the said appeal stands disposed of vide order dated 09.07.2024 and challenge to the same has been raised by way of CWP-15369-2025.

4. On a query of the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner has very fairly submitted that in the above referred writ petition bearing No.CWP-15369-2025, filed against the orders dated 02.05.2025 and 09.07.2024, no interim order has been passed with regard to the said impugned orders. As such, operation of the appellate order passed by the learned State Registrar of Firms and Societies, Haryana, is not effected.

5. In view of the aforesaid, *prima facie*, there is substantial compliance of order dated 07.08.2024 passed by this Court. However, if the petitioner is still aggrieved by the result of elections, it shall be open to the



petitioner to avail judicial review thereagainst, in accordance with law.

6. The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
