Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, for directing respondent No.1 to decide the application for stay (Annexure P-4) of operation of order dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.1 (Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Punjab) for deciding the stay application (Annexure P-4) filed along with the revision petition (ROR-1041-2024) preferred by the petitioners, which was otherwise adjourned to 05.03.2025;

however, an application seeking preponement of the said revision petition/ stay application filed by the petitioners, is stated to be listed for hearing on 19.02.2025.

3. Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents/State, in pursuance to the advance copy of writ petition served upon State of Punjab.

4. Learned State counsel submits that the application seeking preponement of revision petition (ROR-1041-2024)/ stay application filed by the petitioners, are pending consideration before respondent No.1 (Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Punjab) for 19.02.2025. It is further submitted that in all probability the stay application filed along with the revision petition, shall be considered and decided by the concerned Officer/Authority on the date already fixed i.e. 19.02.2025, and not in any case, beyond a period of ten days thereafter, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the concerned parties, in accordance with law.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the respondents/State, learned counsel for the petitioners prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
